Tell Me The Story of Jesus From Childhood To Pentecost

Through the centuries there has been much debate about who Jesus was - was he a good man or a liar? Was he a prophet? Was he the Son of God? Why was he born? Why did he die? There have been hundreds and hundreds of books written on this subject with disagreement as to who Jesus was and why he came to earth, but as Christian educators it is vitally important that we help the children we teach understand these questions and be able to answer them for themselves, as well as to be able to tell why they believe what the Bible says about Jesus.

Colossians 1:15-20 answers the two questions of who he was and why he came to earth, "He (Jesus) is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, sothat in everything he might have the supremacy. For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross."

It is my goal to help children understand who Jesus was and why he came to earth. And as a result, I hope to plant in their hearts the desire to serve and follow Jesus all the days of their lives.
